

Abundance, speed, sharing

Tonal sequences interrupted by interferences and compositional limits produce a set of forces that result in visual slippages and flows. This sequence of paintings maps the result of these unpredictable flows - evoking currents, landscapes and other liquid territories

Mafalda Santos (PT, born in 1980) Graduated in Painting from the Porto Fine Arts Faculty. From 2002 to 2007, she was the programmer at the independent venue PêSSEGOpráSEMANA, in Oporto. Her work has been shown regularly since 2001. In 2007/2008 she received a grant from the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation and the Luso-American Development Foundation (FLAD) to do a residency at Location One, in New York City. She was one of the shortlisted at the EDP New Artists award in 2007.

Alongside Manuel Mesquita, Mafalda Santos currently manages an artistic residencies programme at the Moinho da Fonte Santa in Alandroal, Portugal (Alentejo). Her work can be found in several public collections including that of the EDP, António Cachola, PLMJ and Ilídio Pinho Foundations, and the RAR Group.
